Exhibits may be brought to the Fair building from 9 to 3 on Saturday, October 7. Exhibits must be picked up at the Fair building from 1 to 4 Sunday, October 15. A Fair representative will pick up exhibits from schools or organizations with multiple entries on Thursday, October 5, and Friday, October 6. The exhibits will be returned to schools or organizations by a Fair representative on Monday, October 16.

Overall entries shall be no smaller than 5x7 or larger than 30x40 inches and must be framed or on mat or foam board suitable for hanging. Framed artwork will not be accepted if the hangers and wires are not strong enough to hold the exhibit in place. Heavy, ornate frames are difficult to hang and usually detract from the artwork.
